

Provisional Statement of FIT Terms

The principal terms of our Microtricity FIT terms are explained below. A full Statement of FIT Terms will be sent to you along with your FITs schedule should you decide to sign up to Microtricity. Our full Microtricity Terms & Conditions can be found on our website. This provisional statement is intended only as a guide.

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive the FIT from Ecotricity you will need all of the following:

- An Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS) approved micro generation system
- An approved Generation meter (and Export meter where desired)
- Connection to the National Grid

If you are eligible you will only then be entitled to receive Microtricity Feed in Tariffs from the date that Ecotricity receive your completed application, OR, from the date that Ecotricity receive written confirmation (letter or e-mail) that you wish for Ecotricity to be your Feed in Tariff supplier. Must include MCS certificate.

Registration for FIT scheme

Once Ecotricity has processed your Microtricity application and Ofgem have accepted your generator on the central FIT register, you will be issued with a full Statement of FIT Terms that you will need to agree to before Ecotricity can start paying you.

Metering

To qualify for FIT payments you will need to have installed and approved Total Generation Meter to record everything that your system generates. If your system is larger than 30kW in size then you will also need to have and approved Export Meter installed.

Meter Readings

Upon request you will need to provide Ecotricity with a valid meter reading from your Generation meter (and Export meter if you have one) every 3 months in line with the agreed FIT payment periods. Failure to provide a valid meter reading will mean that you will not be paid until the following period.

Generator information provisions

- You will be required to sign an annual declaration stating that the information you have provided to us and what is held in the Central FIT Register relating to your microgeneration system is accurate and correct.
- You must also notify us immediately of any change to your generator set up.
- There is an obligation on you as the generator to provide relevant generator information and meter readings to Ecotricity.

Tariff Prices

A. Generation Tariff Payments

You will be paid for every unit (kWh) that your system generates based on its size, type and installation date.

B. Export Tariff Payments (where applicable)

You will also be eligible to receive a payment for 3p per kWh for any electricity that is exported to the national grid.

- If you have an export meter this will be based on readings taken from your export meter.
- If you do not have an export meter then Ecotricity will estimate your export at 50% of your total generation for Solar PV, Wind and Anaerobic Digestion, or 75% of the total generation for hydro.

Payments

Payments will be made quarterly, based on the reading/s that you provide. Payment methods will be agreed at the time that your first payment is due to be made.

Ending this Agreement - You

You may terminate this Agreement with Ecotricity at anytime by giving 28 days prior written notice.

Ending this Agreement - Supplier

Ecotricity reserve the right to terminate your FIT agreement at any time if it is shown that you are in breach of your specified FIT terms.

Switching

Should you wish to switch FITs supplier you should inform your new supplier that you are registered for FITs and would like for them to take over responsibility for paying you the FITs. They should then prompt you to provide them with the relevant details which they will use to make all the necessary transfer arrangement with Ecotricity.
